

COMPANY REGISTRATION IN CHINA Wholly Foreign Owned Enterprise (W.F.O.E.)

ADVANTAGES & DISADVANTAGES

Advantages

Independent operations.

Freedom of carrying out *your desired business strategy* without worrying about the Chinese partner factor.

Wide range of business scope.

Exercise all parts of your business *conscientiously*, receiving revenue in RMB, and issuing RMB official invoices to customers.

Lower your operational costs.

- Set up your office in *any* business property.
- Your business tax is calculated based on your turnover, while for corporate income tax, if the expenses and costs do not exceed your turnover, *no tax* will be charged.
- Directly sign a labor contract with your hired employees without having to go through monthly agent fees (i.e. FESCO) – Full control of HR.

Intellectual property.

Benefit from a *priceless* intellectual property and technology know-how *guarantee*.

Capability of Repatriation.

Converting RMB profits to \$US to repatriate to your parent company outside of China.

Disadvantages

Capital requirements.

There will be *minimum capital requirements* to setup a WOFE according to different industries. Normally, 15% of the total investment should be injected within 3 months after you get the business license, the remainder 85% should be settled within two years.

Note: can also be used for working capital (i.e. your own salaries).

Complicated application process for registration.

The registration period takes a minimum of *3 months* and requires a large number of forms to submit to various government departments.
